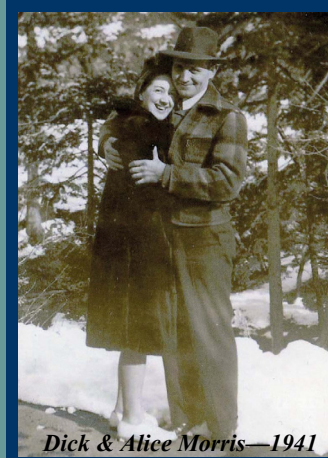

They had one buggy horse, one riding horse and several draft horses used for farming. As a young man, Dick traveled the country, eventually settling in Seattle, where he met and married his wife Alice. They were together until she passed away in 2003, after a lengthy illness.
