Will, 104, & Lois, 101, Clark



At age 100, four years ago, Dr. Will Clark of Arizona not only bought a new van, but drove it, accompanied by Lois, his wife of 75 years, to Illinois to visit their daughter! Will and Lois Clark are one of the very few centenarian couples in America, with Lois having reached the century mark in 2007. The van is necessary because Lois uses a wheelchair. The couple lives independently and Will gets his wife into and out of the van, the wheelchair into and out of the van, and pushes her wherever they need or want to go.

In the last four years, the Clarks have been to San Luis Obispo twice, “driving through Los Angeles traffic” he notes, and obviously driving on the freeways. In June they traveled to New Mexico to visit family, accompanied by their son and his wife. “Dad and I shared the driving,” son Denny said. Can you imagine having your 104-year-old father help you with the driving?
